The program for the weekend will be as follows:

Friday – 20 September

Travel day to Doringkloof at your own leisure. There will be a social braai and drivers briefing at the Bush Camp lapa early evening.

Saturday - 21 September

A mountain route of your choice which will contain hidden treasures and clues to help you solve the tasks at hand. There is no cell phone signal in this area, therefore some general knowledge is required as some of these brain teasers are tricky to solve. Each route will be rated from easy to difficult, however the points will be no different based on difficulty. You will be required to use your own skills to find the hidden items. All points obtained will form your total for the day.

Sunday -22 September

The event will move over the Ghymkana area. Here you will obtain points by taking your vehicle through various obstacles which includes a fun activity within each obstacle. From there we will proceed with a GPS challenge, so make sure your GPS is up to date and that you have honed your skills on operating your GPS.
